The Importance of Maintaining Your Coolant Fluid Level

It is extremely important to accurately maintain the level of Rotella Extended Life Coolant in your International engine. A coolant level monitor is installed inside the surge tank as a standard feature of 2007 emission engines that will aid in keeping the fluid at the optimal desired amount. 2007 emission engines are highly sensitive to coolant fluid levels as well as air pockets in the lines.
