In 2006, Jennings Transportation of Nazareth, PA was the proud recipient of one of the nation's first diesel hybrid electric buses.

IC Bus is pleased to offer two distinct hybrids, charge depleting, plug-in, and charge sustaining, non plug-in. IC Bus has partnered with Enova Systems to produce a hybrid vehicle capable of up to 70% increase in fuel economy and up to 90% reduction in diesel emissions. While both systems achieve an increase in economy and reduction in emissions, IC Bus and Enova recommend the purchase of a plug-in hybrid for best in class fuel economy. The hybrid utilizes an advanced post-transmission design, which does not alter the power train, and lithium-ion battery cells. Since there is no alteration to the power train, every hybrid vehicle purchased through your IC dealer is fully warranted by all International dealers.

The plug-in system is specifically programmed to the customer's route so that the bus operates on both battery and diesel, giving the increase in fuel economy. Once the programmed mileage has been reached, the battery charge has been depleted and the bus operates on diesel power, requiring the bus to be plugged in between runs and recharged.
